

ROBERT EUGENE "BOB" BOWSER



Age 86, of Harwick, passed away peacefully Monday, February 19, 2024, at home, with his loving family by his side. Born May 17, 1937, to the late Paul E. and Anna Ruth (Palmer) Bowser, he was a lifelong resident of the community. A 1955 graduate of Springdale High School, Bob was a star pitcher for both the high school and American Legion baseball teams. His prowess on the mound earned him a training

At the time of his retirement, Bob was a managing partner of the former IGA /Foodland supermarket in Mars. Bob was an active member of Springdale United Methodist Church. In addition to being a devoted usher, he served on numerous church committees over the years. You could also find Bob in the church basement every Easter and Christmas season making candy. Bob's greatest joy was spending time with family and friends, especially onboard a cruise ship or relaxing on the beaches of Ocean City, MD and St. Croix, USVI. He enjoyed playing golf and cheering for his favorite sports teams (the Steelers, Penguins and Pirates) in his own unique way. A decades long season ticket holder for both the Steelers and Penguins, Bob was fortunate enough to attend five of the Steelers eight Super Bowl appearances. Bob is survived by his beloved wife of nearly 65 years, Mary Lou (Haggerty) Bowser; his children, Carol (Bowser) Gras and her husband, Raymond Matsey, of Wilkins Township, Robert J.
