Henry "Hank" Dansak, formerly of McKeesport, passed away on February 20, 2024 in Abington, PA. Hank was born on March 27, 1930, to Henry and Mary (Francis) Dansak. After his primary and secondary education, Hank enlisted in the United States Army.
