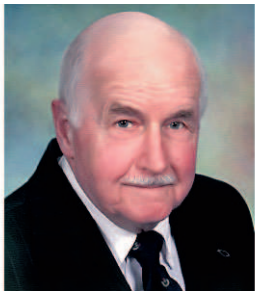


FLOYD CHARLES "BUD" JOHNSON
