After discharge, he played two tours with Author Fielder and the Boston Pops. Frank joined the Pittsburgh Symphony in 1955 and was a member until 1970. He played under William Steinberg, Leonard Bernstein, Leopold Stokowski, Euguene Ormandy, and also Stravinsky and Hindemith. In 2001 when Heinz Hall was built, the Symphony hired Frank as a contractor to provide musicians for the Opera and Ballet and later the Broadway Series and Civic Light Opera as well. He was very proud that he hired local musicians for these events. He joined the Civic Light Orchestra from 1972-2022.
