The scope of work includes approx. 36,000 sy of roadway milling and profiling Superpave WMA binder course, Superpave WMA wearing course, base repair, traffic control, bituminous wedge curb, concrete curb and sidewalk, structure adjustments, ADA ramps, linestriping, add alternates for additional square yards of resurfacing, and all necessary appurtenances and restoration for said construction on various roadways in the Townships of Moon, North Fayette and Crescent. The Crescent Township and Western Allegheny Community Library portions of this project are financed, in part, by the Redevelopment Authority of Allegheny County via a Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund Grant. Compliance is required with the PA Prevailing Wage Act of 1961, P.L. 987, No. 442; Title VI and other applicable provisions of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; the Department of Labor Equal Opportunity Clause (41 CFR 60 -1.4); Executive Order 11625 (Utilization of Minority Business Enterprise); Executive Order 12138 (Utilization of Female Business Enterprise); in compliance with Section 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; the Allegheny County MBE/WBE Program enacted July 1981, which sets forth goals of 13 percent Minority and 2 percent Female Business Enterprise; and the Allegheny County Ord. #6867-12, setting forth goals of 5 percent Veteran Owned Small Businesses. The bid must be accompanied by a bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid, made payable to the Township of Moon to guarantee the bidder's entrance into the contract if given the award.
