Jared Leigh Cohon, died peacefully in Ligonier, Pennsylvania, on March 16th.

Jerry was born on October 7th, 1947, in Beachwood, Ohio. At age seven, he met the love of his life, Maureen "Bunny" Cohon (Nathanson), who was with him at his passing.
