The scope of work includes approximately 5,100 square yards of roadway milling and profiling, 2½" Superpave WMA binder course, Superpave WMA scratch course, and 1½" Superpave WMA wearing course; base repair; structure adjustments to grade; catch basin repairs and replacements; traffic control; linestriping; and all necessary appurtenances and restoration for said construction on various Borough roadways.
