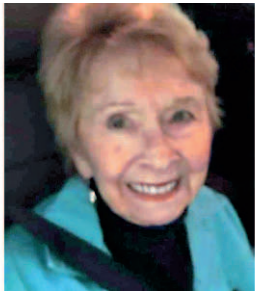


## LARUE BRACKEN GROVES
