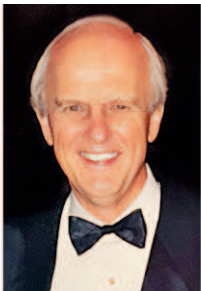


THOMAS RICHARD WROBLEWSKI



Thomas Richard Wroblewski, age 88, of Valencia, PA, was called to eternal life on Good Friday, March 29, 2024, in the comfort of his home, with his family at his side.

Born on Good Friday, April 19, 1935, on Polish Hill, Tom was the eldest son of the late Chester and Blanche Kopicki Wroblewski.

Tom was a graduate of Central Catholic High School, the University of Pittsburgh,
