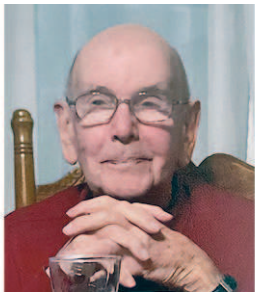


WILLIAM "BILL" WISEMAN
