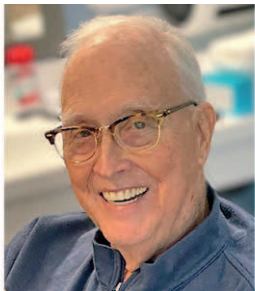


ROBERT E. "BOB" DUVAL
