CONTRACT NO. 24-PK1 OHIO TOWNSHIP PARK IMPROVEMENTS (BRC-PRD-27-177)

The scope of work includes construction of a new park including linestriping of the parking area; new bituminous paved basketball, tennis, and pickleball courts with equipment, fencing, and linestriping; landscaping; add alternates for additional court amenities, and all necessary appurtenances and restoration for said construction.

CONTRACT NO. 24-PW1 SALT STORAGE FACILITY PRE-CAST WALLS PROCUREMENT

This contract consists of furnishing 8' high precast T-Wall design walls (94' deep x approximately 60' back wall variable thickness). All wall sections must be reinforced and be joined together with a tongue and groove joint system.

CONTRACT NO. 24-PW2 SALT STORAGE FACILITY QUONSET HUT CANOPY

This contract consists of furnishing and installing a 60' W x 94' L Galvanized Steel Quonset Hut Canopy.

All bidders are required to buy the Bid Documents in PDF format for a non-refundable deposit of \$175.00 from QuestCDN using project numbers 9052627(PK1), 9060210 (PW1), 9060211 (PW2). Any technical questions regarding the bid documents are to be directed to LSSE. Ohio Township received a C2P2 Grant Award from the DCNR for partial funding of Contract 24-PK1. Bidder must agree to comply with all requirements associated with the Grant. Pennsylvania prevailing wage rates apply. Proposals must be upon the forms furnished by the Township. The bid must be accompanied by a bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid, made payable to Ohio Township to guarantee the bidder's entrance into the contract if given the award. The Township reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive any informalities in the bidding. No bid may be withdrawn for ninety (90) calendar days after the scheduled time for receipt of bids. The Township shall (a) award the construction contract to the lowest responsible bidder therefore, or (b) reject all bids received within ninety (90) days of the date of bid opening; provided, however, that the Township may, in its sole discretion, delay such award or rejection for up to one hundred twenty (120) days from the bid opening date until the Township has received all required approvals from other governmental agencies. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
