This randomized study will help us learn if using the pump helps patients recover better after their heart attack.

The RECOVER IV Study will be conducted during emergency medical situations. Most patients will be too sick to make healthcare decisions or give their consent to participate in the study.

Life-supporting treatments must be given quickly to be effective.
