Sealed Proposals will be received by the Municipality of Bethel Park 5100 West Library Avenue, Bethel Park, PA 15102 until 9:00 A.M. prevailing time on Tuesday, May 14, 2024 for the following Projects:

**OXFORD/HIGHLAND  
ISLAND RECONSTRUCTION  
PROJECT**

This project involves the reconstruction of the concrete island on Oxford Drive and Highland Avenue in the Municipality of Bethel Park, including pedestrian improvements and reconstruction of the concrete median on Highland Avenue. Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope, clearly marked on the outside with the words OXFORD/HIGHLAND ISLAND RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT. Prevailing Wage Rates are required to be paid for this project. There will be a **Mandatory** Pre-bid meeting on, Monday, May 6, 2024, on-site at 10:00 AM at the intersection of Oxford Drive and Highland Avenue. All Contractors who intend to submit a Bid must attend for the Bid to be considered as responsive.

**OXFORD DRIVE SIGNAL  
EQUIPMENT UPGRADES  
PROJECT**

This project involves upgrades to the signalized intersections of Oxford Drive & Alicia Drive and Oxford Drive & Home Depot Drive / Spirit Street. The upgrades at the two (2) intersections include the installation of new traffic signal equipment including vehicular signal heads, pedestrian signal heads, and pedestrian pushbuttons (with associated signage). All associated traffic control and restoration is also included, complete in place. Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the words OXFORD DRIVE SIGNAL EQUIPMENT UPGRADES PROJECT. Prevailing wage rates are required to be paid on this Project. There will be a **Mandatory** Pre-bid meeting on, Monday, May 6, 2024, on-site at 10:30 AM at the intersection of Oxford Drive and Alicia Drive. All Contractors who intend to submit a Bid must attend for the Bid to be considered as responsive.

**HIGHLAND ROAD BRIDGE  
REPAIRS**

This project involves rehabilitation of an existing 100' single-span bridge along Highland Road between Conestoga Drive and Meadowbrook Drive in Bethel Park, PA. The project scope includes, but is not limited to, repairs to existing abutment expansion dams; construction of concrete approach slabs, curbs and sidewalks; bituminous pavement, resealing of joints; concrete sealer, replacement of pedestrian barrier, installation of concrete ADA ramps, replacement of stair railing, replacement of guiderails, traffic control and site restoration. Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the words HIGHLAND ROAD BRIDGE REPAIRS. There will be a **Mandatory** Pre-bid meeting on, Monday, May 6, 2024, at 11:00 AM at 130 Highland Rd, Bethel Park, PA 15102. All Contractors who intend to submit a Bid must attend for the Bid to be considered as responsive.

**All Proposals must be in the hands of Michael Rizzo, P.E. Municipal Engineer, 5100 West Library Avenue, Bethel Park, PA 15102, on or before May 14, 2024 at 9:00 A.M. prevailing time where the same will be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter.** Pennsylvania

**Prevailing Wages are required to be paid on ALL Projects listed as part of this notice.** Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreement for the projects listed are on file and open to public inspection at the office of The Gateway Engineers, Inc., 100 McMorris Road, Pittsburgh, Pa 15205 where sets of said documents may be obtained upon payment of fifty (\$ 50.00) dollars per set. No refund will be made for the return of any documents. A ten (\$10.00) dollar mailing fee will be charged for any documents delivered by U.S. mail. Electronic copies of the Contract Documents will be made available to Bidders at no charge upon request. Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of the Municipality of Bethel Park, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania in an amount equal to ten (10%) percent of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within fifteen (15) days after Notice of the Award of the Contract. Proposals must be made to the Municipality of Bethel Park and shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days. No Bidder may withdraw their Proposal during the sixty (60) day period without forfeiting the Bid guarantee. Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement. Bidders are advised that the Municipality will award each contract to a single qualified, responsive, and responsible Bidder for each Contract based on the lowest Base Bid and any combination of Alternates chosen by the Municipality at its sole discretion. However, Bidders are advised that the Municipality expressly reserves the right to reject all bids, and specifically reserves the right to award to the lowest qualified, responsive, and responsible Bidder a contract for all or any portions of the work listed in the proposal, and in awarding a contract for less than the total work listed, or less than all portions of the work listed, the contract price will be determined from the total quantities for each item listed and the unit price bid for each item listed. The Municipality also reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, or any part thereof, for any reason, and reserves the right to waive any informality therein.
