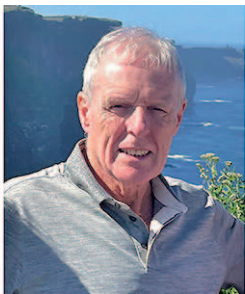


PATRICK CAULFIELD
