NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed Proposals for **Project No. 24-02-SC, 2024 Sealcoat Program** will be received by the Municipality of Monroeville, County of Allegheny, Pennsylvania. Proposals must be made upon Proposal Forms supplied by the Municipality of Monroeville and must be based upon and in accordance with the Specifications and Instructions to Bidders. Copies of said Proposal Forms, Specifications, and Instruction to Bidders may be obtained at the Building, Engineering & Community Development Office of the Municipality of Monroeville, 2700 Monroeville Boulevard, Monroeville, Pennsylvania. All construction drawings and specifications will be provided by the Municipality in PDF format via email upon registration. It will be the bidder's responsibility to generate hard copies for bidding purposes, if desired. All bidders are required to obtain bidding documents (via email) directly from the Municipality. All receiving said information will be required to register with the Municipality providing pertinent information including, but not limited to, name of company, address and contact information. Anyone submitting a bid which did not register with the Municipality of Monroeville will be rejected without consideration of their bid. Each Proposal must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bid Bond in the amount specified in the Instructions to Bidders and made payable to the order of the Municipality of Monroeville. All Proposals must be in the hands of the Monroeville Municipal Manager, 2700 Monroeville Boulevard, Monroeville, Pennsylvania, on or before **9:00 a.m., Thursday, May 2nd, 2024**, and the same will be publicly opened and read in the Monroeville Municipal Council Chambers immediately thereafter.
