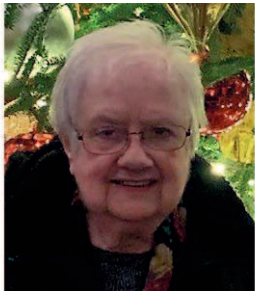


CAROL PHILLIPS BATTLES
