## E. LAVERNE PETRIE



Age 93, of Moon Township, passed away peacefully in the early hours of Friday, April 12, 2024, at Apple Blossom Senior Living Center.

LaVerne was born September 15, 1930, in Pittsburgh, PA, the daughter of William E. Lins and Grace Evelyn Lins, née Barr, and was a graduate of Langley High School. She married the love of her life, William A. Petrie in July of 1949, and together they raised five

She also enjoyed traveling to craft shows with her daughters, daughters-in-law, and sisterin-law Florence.
