J. Frank Doney, Jr., age 94, passed away at his home in Bakerstown, Allegheny County, PA, on April 18, 2024 after a long illness.

Born in Indiana, PA on February 9, 1930, he was the son of the late Jay Frank Doney, Sr. and Virginia Irene Raybould Doney.

A U.S. Marine Veteran, Frank served in the First Marine Division as a field musician and bugler during the Korean War and
