Addenda, if any, will be issued to only those persons whose name and address are on record at Bankson Engineers, Inc. as having obtained the Bidding Documents. Bids will be accepted only from Bidders who have obtained official sets of Bidding Documents from Bankson Engineers, Inc. and who are on Bankson Engineers, Inc.'s list of planholders. The Bid Proposal must be a paper copy, with an original signature, submitted in an envelope along with the original bid security, all as described in Section 00 21 13 – Instructions to Bidders. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bidder's bond in favor of the Aleppo Township Authority in the amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the proposal. These Contracts are subject to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act. Workers must be paid not less than the minimum wages established by the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry, as shown in the applicable schedule. The Authority reserves the right to waive any informality in and to accept or reject any and all bids. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.
