Nathaniel "Nat" Miljus, Jr., age 84, of Upper St. Clair, PA, passed away on Wednesday, May 1, 2024 surrounded by his family. Born December 23, 1939, he was the son of the late Lieutenant Colonel Nathaniel and Dorothy (Yurjevic) Miljus.
