

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED AMMENDMENTS TO ALLEGHENY COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

ARTICLE XXI, AIR POLLUTION CONTROL

The Allegheny County Board of Health (ACHD) will hold a public hearing on **Thursday June 13, 2024, at 5:00 PM**, in the Highmark Meeting Room #302 of CCAC Allegheny North Campus, K. Leroy Irvis Building, to take testimony on proposed modifications to Article XXI and County Ordinance 16782 that include revisions to Sections 2101.20 Definitions, 2105.10 Surface Coating Processes, and 2105.18.b Dry Cleaning Facilities – Petroleum Solvent Dry Cleaning Facilities, and the addition of Section 2105.19A Synthetic Organic Chemical Manufacturing Industry – Air Oxidation, Distillation and Reactor Processes. The amendments to §2101.20, §2105.10, and §2105.18.b, as well as the addition of §2105.19A will be submitted as revisions to Allegheny County's portion of the Pennsylvania State Implementation Plan (SIP) for the Attainment and Maintenance of National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS).
