

WILLIAM "BILL" PARKE TRANTER, JR.



Age 82, of Masonic Village, Sewickley, PA, died on Sunday, March 31, 2024. Diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in September 2022, he defied his prognosis and persevered with great grace, dignity, and his ever-present humor and wit until his death.
