

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR REVISION OF ALLEGHENY COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS ARTICLE VI (HOUSING AND COMMUNITY ENVIRONMENT)**

**Allegheny County Board of Health**

The Allegheny County Board of Health will hold a public hearing on Thursday, June 6, 2024, at 5:00 PM, at 807 Wallace Avenue, Wilkinsburg, PA 15221, to take testimony on the proposed revision of Allegheny County Health Department Article VI (Housing and Community Environment):

Article VI is the regulation that grants the Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD) Housing and Community Environment Program the authority to inspect and enforce minimum property standards and public health requirements for dwellings and premises in Allegheny County. The Article defines the requirements for how properties must be maintained inside and outside in order to keep residents and communities safe. The proposed revisions to Article VI would establish a Housing Advisory Committee to work with the ACHD and Board of Health on matters related to the work of the ACHD Housing and Community Environment Program.
