CONCESSION FACILITY

Contract No. 24-PK2 – General Construction generally consists of construction of masonry concession and restroom building (approximately 22'x35') including concrete sidewalk, concrete floor, toilet partitions and standing seam roof.

Contract No. 24-PK3 – Plumbing generally consists of the water and sanitary service connections, plumbing fixtures, hot and cold water piping, hot water tank and drinking fountain for the proposed restrooms.

Contract No. 24-PK4 – Electrical generally consists of the electrical service, new panelboard, all wiring, conduit and lighting systems.

Contract No. 24-PK5 – Mechanical generally consists of the installation of exhaust fans and air louvers.

This project is being financed, in part, by the RAAC via a GEDTF Grant. Bidder must agree to comply with all requirements associated with the Grant. Compliance is required with the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of 1961, P.L. 987, No. 442; Title VI and other applicable provisions of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; the Department of Labor Equal Opportunity Clause (41 CFR 60 -1.4); Executive Order 11625 (Utilization of Minority Business Enterprise); Executive Order 12138 (Utilization of Female Business Enterprise); in compliance with Section 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; the Allegheny County MBE/WBE Program enacted July 1981, which sets forth goals of 13 percent Minority and 2 percent Female Business Enterprise; and the Allegheny County Ordinance #6867-12, setting forth goals of 5 percent Veteran Owned Small Businesses. The bid must be accompanied by a bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid, made payable to the Township of Ohio to guarantee the bidder's entrance into the contract if given the award. The Township reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive any informalities in the bidding. No bid may be withdrawn for ninety (90) calendar days after the scheduled time for receipt of bids.
