Copies of the documents may be obtained with a check or money order deposit (non-refundable) made payable to Glenn Engineering & Associates, Ltd. in the amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) PER EACH SET. Requests for mailing will be honored with an additional fee of Eighteen Dollars (\$18.00) PER EACH SET. **NO documents will be issued within 48 hours of the scheduled bid opening.** Each proposal shall be accompanied by a Bidder's Bond, Cashier's Check, or Certified Check in favor of the City of Clairton in the amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the proposal, as evidence the bidder will accept and carry out the conditions of the contract in case of award. This contract shall be subject to the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, 43 P.S. Section 165 et seq. Workers shall not be paid less than the prevailing minimum wages as set forth in the applicable schedule. Bidders **MUST** be Pre-Qualified by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to perform all associated work on this project. An **On-Site Pre-Bid Job Site Meeting** will be held on **Tuesday, June 11, 2024 at 1:00PM, Prevailing Time.** This Meeting is **NOT** Mandatory, but highly recommended. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days once filed with the City of Clairton. The City of Clairton reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality in the bids received.
