Allegheny Arsenal Burial Pits Munitions Response Site

Restoration Advisory Board

Public Interest Solicitation

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Baltimore District is gaging the public's interest in creating a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) for the former Allegheny Arsenal Burial Pits Munitions Response Site (MRS) Phase I Remedial Investigation (RI). The goal of this non-intrusive RI is to determine if potential discarded military munitions still exist at this historic site as single items or within burial pits. If a RAB is created (based enough community interest), the RAB would review past and future planned actions at the MRS. During a RAB Meeting, USACE would give a status update regarding ongoing environmental investigations and restoration activities at the former Allegheny Arsenal Munitions Depot - Burial Pits MRS.

What is a RAB? A RAB is a stakeholder group that meets on a regular basis to discuss restoration at a specific property that is either currently or was formerly owned by DoD, but where DoD oversees the environmental process.

What is the purpose of a RAB? A RAB provides the community with the opportunity to become involved in the environmental restoration process.

What activities can RABs undertake? RABs review and comment on environmental restoration documents and activities, provide information to the public and receive input from the community. If you are interested in forming a RAB for the Allegheny Arsenal Burial Pits MRS please send an email to:
