The Solicitor prepared this summary: This proposed Ordinance creates Section 184-916 on Trees and wooded areas to regulate existing tree vegetation on new plans 10 acres or more by protecting trees of significance, preserving certain wooded areas, addressing tree replacement and mitigation, and establishing maintenance requirements. A copy of the full text of the proposed Ordinance may be examined by any citizen at the Franklin Park Municipal Building, at the newspaper publishing this legal notice, and at the office of the Allegheny County Council Chief Clerk, Allegheny County Courthouse, Pittsburgh, PA, during regular business hours.
