PITTSBURGH – The Advisory Council of the Allegheny County Department of Human Services, Area Agency on Aging (AAA) will hold a public hearing on Friday, June 14, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. The purpose of the hearing is to provide information on the FY 23/24 Budget, Information on Aging's Four (4) year plan, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Aging Our Way PA/State Master Plan on Aging and Age Friendly PA. Due to expressed concerns regarding health and safety risks associated with large public gatherings in limited spacing, the public hearing will be conducted in-person and via video and teleconference. The teleconference meeting will feature closed captioning as well as live American Sign Language Interpretation.
