Residual Waste Landfill Closure Plan

On or about July 31, 2024, Marlborough US Realty Holdings, LP (Marlborough) is planning on submitting a closure plan to the Pennsylvania (PA) Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for closure of the Ambridge Landfill, a Class III residual waste landfill. This notification is being provided in accordance with Title 25, Chapter 287, Section 151 of the PA Code. The Ambridge landfill is located in the Borough of Ambridge, Beaver County, off of Breitenstein Road. The landfill ceased receiving waste around 1988, and was regraded, covered with soil, and revegetated around 2002. The closure plan is being submitted in accordance with Title 25, Chapter 287 of the PA Code to officially close the landfill in accordance with Department of Environmental Protection regulations. Copies of the closure plan are available for review and copying at the PADEP Southwest Regional Office at 400 Waterfront Drive, Pittsburgh, PA 15222 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. An appointment to review the document must be made by calling the PADEP at 412-442-4000. Fees for copying may be charged by the PADEP. Copies of the closure plan will also be submitted to Ambridge Borough and to the Beaver County office by the PADEP. The host municipality and county may submit comments to the PADEP within 60 days of receipt of the closure plan, recommending conditions upon, revisions to and approval or disapproval of the closure plan, with the specific reason described in the comments. The PADEP will accept comments from the public on the closure plan during review.
