other required documents and the taking of all other required action; (23) declaring the ordinance to be the form of official intent of the County pursuant to 1.150-2 of U.S. Treasury Regulations for purposes of reimbursing the County from proceeds of the C-80 Bonds for certain capital expenditures previously made by the County; and (24) repealing inconsistent ordinances.
