The Resolution approved the sale of the Bonds at a private sale by negotiation and accepted a proposal for the purchase of the Bonds (the Purchase of the Bonds (the Purchase of the Bonds (the Purchase of the Bonds) from Stifel Nicolaus & Company Incorporated (the rurchase from Stifel, from Stifel, incolaus & Company, Incorporated (the Underwriter) at a purchase price not less than 95% and not more than 125% of the principal amount of the Bonds (including the Underwriter's discount for the Bonds, plus original issue premium (if any) for the Bonds, less original issue discount (if any) for the Bonds, plus accrued interest, if any. Pursuant to the terms of the Resolution and Purchase Proposal, the Bonds will bear interest at rates not less than 0% and not more than 6.00% per annum and the Underwriter's shall per annum
