The West View Water Authority, Allegheny County, PA hereby gives notice that it is requesting a Categorical Exclusion from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection with respect to the **Lead Service Line Replacement Project – Phase 3**. The project will be located within the Authority service area communities including Avalon, Bellevue, Ben Avon, Emsworth, Kennedy, McKees Rocks, Pittsburgh, Ross, Stowe, and West View. The project includes the installation of new copper service from the existing water main to the curb stop at the right-of-way. In some cases, where the private portion of the water service is a lead pipe, the private portion of the service will be replaced with copper pipe and new backflow preventers, pressure reducers, and isolation valves will be installed. All lead shall be removed from any service completed by the project. The project is being funded primarily from a PENNVEST grant/loan and will have no impact on existing user fees.
