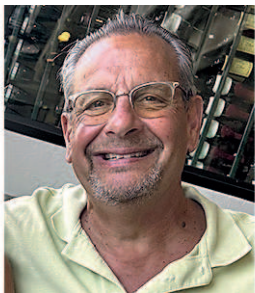


KENNETH JAMES KALLIS
