She worked as a legal secretary at her son-in-law's law firm until she retired at ninety-one. Gloria not only learned to become a skilled legal secretary, but she served as a model and mentor to many young secretaries, and even some of the young attorneys, who came up through the firm.

Gloria was a great dancer and joined a theatrical group called The Independents. The group played show tunes at a dinner theatre at the Crown Plaza in Moon. They also brought their shows to nursing homes and even played in Las Vegas on several occasions. They counted among their members Josie Carey. She also was the favorite babysitter for her grandchildren, who all loved her greatly. Gloria was the strength of the family. Her children will miss her humor, love and friendship.
