Age 96, talented sculptor in stone and bronze, and wife of Hungarian Freedom Fighter, Francis S. Csorba (d. 2006, Pgh. PA), who fled with their two daughters, seven and five, from communist-occupied Hungary in 1956 to the United States, died in Sacramento, California on June 19, 2024. Matriarch of four generations of the Csorba family, Ilona was mother of Helena, Mrea, Francis (Susanne), and Csilla; grandmother of Anthony Colon, Lilla Heyden,
