Ethan Downie Osterhout, 35, of Indiana, passed away Saturday, July 6, 2024.

A son of Karl E. Osterhout and Alison J. Downie, he was born Aug. 6, 1988, in Pittsburgh.

Ethan relished being a Pittsburgher, even while he lived in Georgia for several years after graduating from Towson University. He had lived in Indiana since 2020.

Ethan enjoyed sports, was a loyal fan of the Steelers and the Penguins, and Primanti's was his favorite restaurant. As a little boy, Ethan loved Thomas the Tank Engine trains. As an adult, he often wore a t-shirt featuring a Thomas train logo.

Ethan enjoyed cooking, sampling hot sauces, and reading Anthony Bourdain. He loved music and was a skilled bass guitarist. His favorite band was Primus, a bass-centric group. In recent years, Ethan spent a great deal of time composing beats himself, posting his compositions on bandcamp under the name rebbo:
