Sealed Bids for the design/build construction of the remediation of the Beaver Road Retaining Wall, Contract No. 01-24 will be received by the Borough of Edgeworth (Owner) at its offices located at 301 Beaver Road, Sewickley, PA 15143 until 10:00 A.M. local time on August 5, 2024, at which time the bids will be publicly opened.

Contract Description:  
**The remediation of the existing Beaver Road Retaining wall project entails a design/build soil nail stabilization of an approximately 503-ft-long portion of the existing aged composite retaining structure providing support to Beaver Road, immediately superjacent to, and east of the aged retaining wall. Although much of the existing wall is considered to be within the Beaver Road right-of-way, areas immediately west of the wall are owned by private property owners, as indicated on drawings accompanying the bid submittal documents. Work will consist of the design of the soil nails and/or micropiles, and shotcreting, to stabilize the designated portion of the existing wall, presented as the base bid that includes the remediation of the portion of the existing retaining wall as depicted on the accompanying drawings. The remedial area generally stretches from the existing wall's southeastern terminus to an existing earthen buttress approximately 503 lin ft to the northwest. Dyed shotcrete shall be included as part of the base bid. The dye color will be chosen by the Borough. Beaver Road, a relatively high-volume roadway, must remain open via a minimum of one lane, including appropriate maintenance and protection of traffic, during remedial operations, that shall consist of traffic signals and associated elements. The Owner anticipates the stabilization will generally include soil nailing and appropriate components thereof. Other remedial approaches will not be considered.**

Prospective Bidders may obtain a hard copy of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M., and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of \$700.00. However, **arrangements must be made at least one full business day prior to arrival at the Garvin Boward Beitko Engineering, Inc., office, to schedule the date and time of your retrieval of hard copy documents.**

Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to Garvin Boward Beitko Engineering, Inc. Bidders must purchase Bidding Documents from Garvin Boward Beitko Engineering, Inc., to be eligible to bid. Copies of the Contract Documents can be mailed to prospective Bidders upon receipt of the \$700.00 non-refundable fee plus a \$50.00 mailing fee. In lieu of a hard copy of the documents, if requested of Garvin Boward Beitko Engineering, Inc., by the aforementioned phone contact, a pdf electronic copy of the documents can be sent via email upon receipt of a \$500.00 non-refundable fee. Checks must be made out to Garvin Boward Beitko Engineering, Inc. Credit card orders will not be accepted. A **mandatory** pre-bid meeting will be held at **10:00 A.M. local time on Wednesday, July 31, 2024**, at the Borough office, located at the aforementioned address, with a site visit (weather permitting) to follow immediately thereafter. Bid security – including a performance bond, labor and material payment bond, and bid bond, shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. The Owner reserves the right, without limitation, to reject any or all Bids, including, nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced, unqualified, or conditional Bids. Owner also reserves the right to waive all minor informalities not involving price, time, or changes in the Work. Only documents obtained directly from the Engineer will be valid at bid opening.

*Compliance is required with the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of 1961, P.L. 987, No. 442; Title VI and other applicable provisions of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; the Department of Labor Equal Opportunity Clause (41 CFR 60-1.4); Executive Order 11625 (Utilization of Minority Business Enterprise); Executive Order 12138 (Utilization of Female Business Enterprise); in compliance with Section 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; the Allegheny County MBE/WBE Program enacted July, 1981, which sets forth goals of 13 percent Minority and 2 percent Female Business Enterprise; and the Allegheny County Ordinance #6867-12, setting forth goals of 5 percent Veteran Owned Small Businesses.*

Bidders for this project will be required to comply with the Provisions of the Public Works Employment Verification Act (PWEVA). No bid or any part thereof shall be withdrawn by Bidder for a period of sixty days subsequent to the Bid Opening. The right is reserved by the Owner to reject any or all Bids or part of bids and to waive technical defects in any Bid. Portions of this project are financed, in part, by the Redevelopment Authority of Allegheny County via a Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund Grant.
