Tom became President of the Penn State Alumni Association and was a loyal Penn State fan, frequently traveling to Nittany Lion football home, away and bowl games.

He sang in the Mendelsohn Choir of Pittsburgh for decades and was board president, practiced piano daily and rarely

missed a performance of the Pittsburgh Symphony.
