

CLARENCE BENTON, JR.



Age 93, passed away on July 6, 2024, at Lampasas Assisted Living in Lampasas, Texas. He was born on October 28, 1930, in Akron, Ohio to Clarence and Blanche Ross Benton.

Clarence grew up in Akron, Ohio. He graduated from Turtle Creek High School in

Clarence married Florence Toth in 1956 in Pittsburgh, PA. They were happily married for 54 years. He enjoyed golfing, working crossword puzzles, and spending time with his family.

Clarence was preceded in death by his wife, Florence, and his granddaughter, Morgan.
