

Legal Notice

Wilkinsburg Borough is filing a Notice of Intent (NOI) with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to renew its PAG-13 Permit for the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) located within Wilkinsburg Borough, Allegheny County. As part of this application, a Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP) is to be submitted with the NOI. DEP requires that applicants preparing a new PRP shall give public notice to the residents of the municipality in which the MS4 is located. A copy of the PRP can be publicly viewed at the Wilkinsburg Borough Municipal Building. Written comments about the PRP will be accepted for thirty (30) days from August 1, 2024 through August 30, 2024 at the Borough Offices. Discussion and comments relating to the MS4 program and the PRP will be received from the public at the Infrastructure and Blight Committee Meeting, held on Monday, August 5, 2024 at 6:00 pm at the Wilkinsburg Borough Municipal Building Council Chambers, located at 605 Ross Avenue, Wilkinsburg, PA 15221 and via Zoom; information for Zoom meeting available at www.wilkinsburgpa.gov

. Wilkinsburg Borough plans on removing 10% of the sediment entering unnamed tributaries to Chalfant Run and Turtle Creek through the installation of various Best Management Practices such as vegetative open channels and stream bank restoration. The period to complete these projects is 5 years from the issuance of the PAG-13 Permit.
