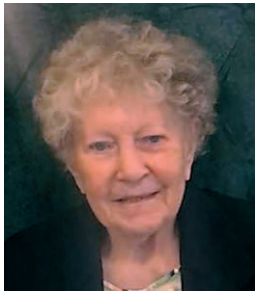


PHYLIS ANN COUILLARD
