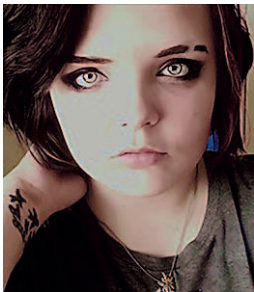


JORDAN MICHELLE LIBERATORE
