She enjoyed travel, coconut treats, bird watching from her porch, shooing squirrels from the bird feeders, and creating various crafts (especially reed baskets).

Ruth was the beloved mother of Carol (Graydon) Brewer of Oakmont, PA, David (Dawn) Crumrine of Roaring Spring, PA, and Duane (Jo) Crumrine of Martinsburg, PA. She loved having her grandchildren around her - Kelsey Brewer (Kyle Allen), Kristin Brewer (Paul Janowicz), Kyle (Brittany) Brewer, Troy (Mary) Crumrine, Chad (Tori) Crumrine, Dana (Chris) Aavampato, and Cari (Aaron) Keebaugh.
