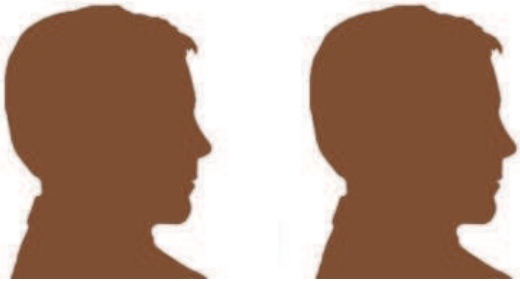


# JESSE GRIFFIN
