Age 63, of Cranberry Township, PA, passed away on August 12th. He was born in the family home to Sujit and Hena Chatterjee on October 22, 1960, in New Delhi, India, but grew up in Kolkata, formerly Calcutta, with many aunts, uncles, and cousins nearby.
