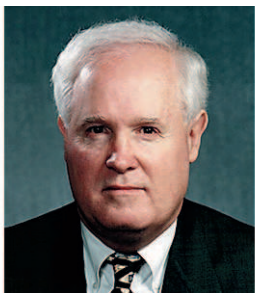


# BARRY JAMES McGEE
