Contract A – Dell Avenue & McFarland Avenue

This project involves upgrades to the signalized intersection of Dell Avenue and MacFarland Avenue in Dormont Borough. The upgrades include the purchase and installation of new traffic signal equipment including traffic signal mast arms, LED countdown pedestrian signals, ADA compliant pushbuttons, emergency vehicle preemption, battery backup power supply, and installation of new signal wiring, conduit, signage, and junction boxes. All associated traffic control and restoration is also included, complete in place.

Contract B – West Liberty Avenue & Kelton Avenue

This project involves improvements to the pedestrian crossing of West Liberty Avenue and Kelton Avenue in Dormont Borough. The upgrades include the purchase and installation of Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs), new pavement markings, new signage, and the removal of existing parking meters. All associated traffic control and restoration is also included, complete in place. All proposals shall be clearly marked Dormont Borough Traffic Improvements Project and must be in the hands of Jason Dailey, Interim Borough Manager, Borough of Dormont, 1444 Hillsdale Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15216 on or before Wednesday, September 25, 2024, 2024, at 10:30 a.m. prevailing time and the same will be opened and read publicly immediately thereafter. The Proposals must be made to the Borough of Dormont, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days. No Bidder may withdraw the Proposal during the sixty (60) day period without forfeiting the Proposal guarantee. Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Rates are required to be paid on these Contracts.
