Harry Joseph Kroll, 59, passed away peacefully on his own terms, surrounded by family and friends on Sunday, September 1, 2024. Harry established himself as a fierce and brave fighter throughout his short battle with Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS). Born in Pittsburgh, PA, on September 23, 1964, son of the late John Kroll Sr. and Anne Wenger Kroll. Beloved husband for 33 years to Deb Schilberg Kroll;

He wanted his struggle to contribute to understanding the underlying causes of ALS and other neurodegenerative diseases.

In accordance with Harry's wishes, there will be no formal funeral service. In true Harry fashion, he already hosted his own funeral and wake this summer! During his Final Farewell Tour, he was able to spend time with hundreds that loved him. Live music, food, drinks, laughter, and time together ensured a great way to honor a great man.
