The scope of work includes the rubberized crack sealing on Waterfront Drive (approximately 60,000 linear feet). All work shall be constructed according to the Contract Drawings and Specifications which are on file at the office of the Owner and LSSE, 846 Fourth Avenue, Coraopolis, Pennsylvania 15108-1522. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud approximately at 11:00 AM on September 30, 2024 at the Steel Rivers COG office located at 1705 Maple Street, Homestead, Pennsylvania 15120. Bid Documents are being distributed by Ditto Document Solutions, 1020 Ridge Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15233. All bidders are required to buy the full set of drawings and specifications for a non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 from Ditto Document Solutions at www.dittoplanroom.com. Any technical questions regarding the bid documents are to be directed to LSSE (412-264-4400, Ext. 284). Proposals must be upon the forms furnished by the Steel Rivers COG. The bid must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid, made payable to the Steel Rivers Council of Governments to guarantee the bidder's entrance into the contract if given the award. The Steel Rivers COG reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive any informalities in the bidding. No bid may be withdrawn for ninety (90) calendar days after the scheduled time for receipt of bids. Attention is directed to the fact that procurement is subject to all requirements of the Pennsylvania Steel Products Procurement Act, Act No. 1978-3; and for Contract value exceeding \$25,000, the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act (Act of 1961 P.L. 987), and The Public Works Employment Verification Act (July 2012) apply. The Steel Rivers COG shall (a) award the construction contract to the lowest responsible bidder therefore, or (b) reject all bids received within ninety (90) days of the date of bid opening; provided, however, that the Council may, in its sole discretion, delay such award or rejection for up to one hundred twenty (120) days from the bid opening date until the Steel Rivers COG has received all required approvals from other governmental agencies. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
